

Data Facts

How do colleges and universities know they are practicing shared governance? 78% of Chief Academic Officers strongly agree or agree tenure is important and valuable at their institution.

Chief Academic Officers believe a faculty's teaching role is more important than their research role.

How do colleges and universities gauge student success? 97% of Chief Academic Officers indicated their institution is providing a "quality education". More than 9 in 10 Chief Academic Officers stated their institutions offer professional development to promote student success.
